## Sigurður (Sig) M Magnússon

Sigurður (Sig) M Magnússon graduated from the Niels Bohr Institute of the University of Copenhagen in 1981 with a cand scient degree in theoretical nuclear physics. He has been the director, since 1981, of the Icelandic Radiation Safety Authority which is the national authority in Iceland for all aspects of radiation and nuclear safety and security. Sigurður is an advisor to the Government of Iceland on international aspects of radiation and nuclear safety and security and to the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in Iceland on IAEA matters since 1998.



Sigurður served as President of the Nordic Radiation Protection Society from 1994 to 1996 and from 2008 to 2011. He was a member of IRPA's Admission Committee from 2000 to 2008 and the core group of the Program Committee for the IRPA 11 in Madrid 2004 and IRPA 12 in Buenos Aires 2008.

Sigurður has been a member of the board of Nordic Nuclear Research (www.nks.org) since 1986 and chairman of the board since 2006. He has been the Icelandic delegate/alternate to the IAEA General Conference since 1998 and was chair of the IAEA Radiation Safety Standards Committee (RASSC) from 2005 to 2011.

Sigurður is a member of the NEA Committee on Radiation Protection and Public Health, (CRPPH) since 1985, a member of the CRPPH bureau since 2005 and a member of the NEA Steering Committee since 2002. He is also chair of the NEA Expert Group on Regulatory Implications of ICRP Recommendations, EGIR group since 2002.

Sigurður is a member of ICRP Committee 4 since 2009 and chair of HERCA, Heads of European Radiation Control Authorities(www.herca.org), since 2012.
